

## Inner Container Manual

Remove the rescue system from your RANGE X-ALPS.





Pull the rubberband through the eyelets as shown in picture 4. Depending on the volume of your rescue you can adjust the size of the inner container.

Seperate the rescue from original inner container. If necessary check the user manual of your rescue system.





Close the four-leaf inner container as shown in picture 5.

Put the rescue with the rescue leash lenghtwise into the new RANGE X-ALPS inner container.





Create a loop with the rescue leash and secure it with the rubberband





## Inner Container Manual

Connect the V-line of your RANGE X-ALPS to the rescue system and attach the rescue handle to the inner container.





Close the whole system as explained in the user manual of your RANGE X-ALPS

The rescue system should appear as shown in picture 8.





Check if the rescue is compatible with your RANGE X-ALPS by pulling the rescue out of the harness. **The pilot has to do this by him/herself.** 

Put the rescue system into your RANGE X-ALPS as shown in picture 9. Positioned with the handle-attachment on the top right side in flight direction.
